Mr. Schonberg holds a bachelor degree in Medical Sciences from the University of Toronto, as well as a master's in Health Administration from the University of Toronto. He is a member in both the Canadian College of Health Service Executives and the American College of Health Care Executives, and is a surveyor with the Canadian Council on Health Services Accreditation. Mr. Schonberg serves as chairman of the Regional Information Technology Steering Committee, which is dedicated to integrating patient information and systems across the continuum of care providers. He has also served on various community boards and is active in community fundraising activities.
